If you only use our service for Vacation Care please sign up for automatic deduction of your fees in the [Xplor parent portal](#).

If you have not used Ironside OSHC for 8 weeks or more please ensure that you have signed a new CWA prior to the commencement of Vacation Care. You will not be eligible for Childcare Subsidy until you have completed a new CWA.

Please note that excursions are charged at an additional cost as detailed on the booking form(s) below.

BOOKINGS

Bookings are essential prior to your child attending.

Sessions cancelled within 14 days of the booked session will be charged at the full fee.

FOOD / DRINK

Children are required to bring a packed lunch each day. We will provide morning tea, afternoon tea and a fruit snack. During Vacation Care, breakfast is not provided. **We cannot heat/reheat children's food.** We strive to be a completely **nut-free and egg-free service**; please do not send these foods with your child. Please pack a water bottle for your child.

HATS / SHOES

All children must have a hat to play outside. It is also essential that all children wear enclosed shoes. Sneakers and socks are the best option as we have many sporting activities.

SUN SAFETY

Parents are reminded that sun safe, appropriate outdoor clothing (i.e. which covers children's shoulders) is to be worn at all times to minimise the risk of sun exposure. This means no sleeveless tops. Sunscreen will be provided to children.

MEDICATION / ILLNESS

If your child is required to take any medication whilst at Vacation Care, please complete a Medication Administration Form (available from the Coordinator). Place the medication in a labelled snap lock bag. All medication must be in original packaging, have a chemist's label indicating the child's name and dosage to be given. Any child with an infectious condition is not to attend Vacation Care.

PERSONAL COMPUTER GAMES / ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Your own portable games (e.g. iPod Touch, PSP, Nintendo DS etc.) are allowed to be brought to Vacation Care at your own risk. These cannot be played at times where other programmed activity is taking place. Only G-rated games can be played. Devices with a 3G-4G reception are not allowed. On devices equipped with a camera, photography of other children is not permitted.

EXCURSIONS

Excursion places are limited to 48 children per trip. Bookings for excursions are accepted on a first come first served basis. By submitting the excursion permission form, you are booking your child into the excursion. Excursion fees are an additional cost to the programme and are not refundable. They need to be completed at the time of booking your child into vacation care. Excursion bookings will close at Monday prior to the excursion or when they are full.

Monday 16th December



Construction Day

WEEK TWO – January 2020

Monday 6th January

Tuesday 7th January

We'll make some under water diagrams that depict life under the sea and have sensory water play where we can re-enact life in the water. Wednesday 8th January

Excursion: Flagstone Park

Some of our students will be heading off to Flagstone Adventure Park to explore a new playground. The students who remain at the service will be exploring the great outdoors with nature play and water play. The students will be trying their hands at a scavenger hunt on the oval and making chalk drawings in L Block.

Thursday 9th January

The students will be able to get their creative juices flowing as they make their own structures in loose parts and make creations to make stop motion movies in the hall. The students will be creating their own games on the oval and creating wonderful creations in arts and craft room.

Monday 13th January

Tuesday 14th January

The students will be exploring the world of reptiles as we have the guys from Deadly Australians coming in to show us some of the deadliest creatures that inhabit Australia. The students will also be making snakes of their own and imaging themselves as animals from Australia.

Frozen Day

Excursion: Ice Skating at Acacia Ridge!

Some of our students are going out to the Acacia Ridge Ice World to experience some cold weather sports of ice-skating! Whilst they are off on their adventure the students who remain at the service will be making their own snow and experiencing their own cold weather game of curling.

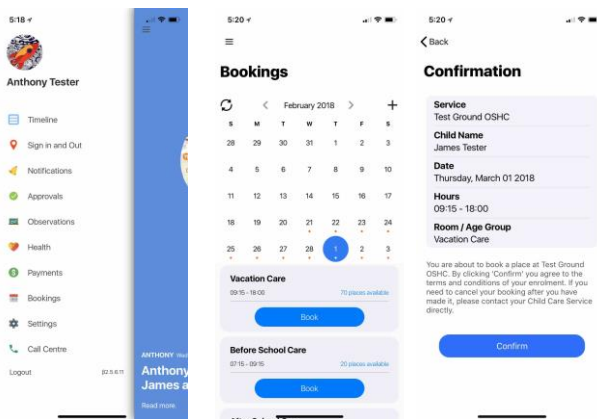




HOW TO BOOK
