## FEES

---

**\$45.00 / DAY PLUS ANY ADDITIONAL ACTIVITY COST OUTLINED ON PROGRAM EARLY BIRD FEE. MUST BE BOOKED IN BY 4<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER 2020. NON EARLY BIRD FEE \$52.00 / PLUS ANY ADDITIONAL ACTIVITY COST.**

If you only use our service for Vacation Care please sign up for automatic deduction of your fees in the [Xplor parent portal](#).

If you have not used Ironside OSHC for 8 weeks or more, please ensure that you have signed a new CWA prior to the commencement of Vacation Care. You will not be eligible for Childcare Subsidy until you have completed a new CWA.

Please note that excursions and incursions are charged at an additional cost as detailed on the booking form(s) below. **Please note the changes to this Vacation Care program we are trialling some days with split age divisions.**

## BOOKINGS

---

Bookings are essential prior to your child attending. **All children if booked in must attend the excursion for that day, therefore no outside activities like swimming or tennis will be allowed on excursion days.**

Sessions cancelled within 14 days of the booked session will be charged at the full fee.

## FOOD / DRINK

---

Children are required to bring morning tea and pack lunch each day. We will provide breakfast, afternoon tea and late afternoon fruit snack. During Vacation Care, we will **NOT** supply morning tea. **We cannot heat/reheat children's food.** We strive to be a completely **nut-free and egg-free service**; please do not send these foods with your child. Please pack a water bottle for your child. Any child that does not bring enough food for the day and requires us to supply additional food will be charged a \$5.00 food fee. It is important that children bring a water bottle on excursions days as they may not always have access to a bubbler at some venues. Any child that is required to be supplied a water bottle for an excursion will be charged an additional water bottle fee of \$2.00.

## HATS / SHOES

---

All children must have a hat to play outside. It is also essential that all children wear enclosed shoes. Sneakers and socks are the best option as we have many sporting activities. Any child that does not bring a hat will be charged a \$2.00 hat fee.

## SUN SAFETY

---

Parents are reminded that sun safe, appropriate outdoor clothing (i.e. which covers children's shoulders) is always to be worn to minimise the risk of sun exposure. This means no sleeveless tops. Sunscreen will be provided to children. Please remember that on any water activity days **ALL** children must wear a **sun shirt or a t-shirt** in the pool or for water play activities.

## MEDICATION / ILLNESS

---

If your child is required to take any medication whilst at Vacation Care, please complete a Medication Administration Form (available from the service). Place the medication in a labelled snap lock bag. All medication must be in original packaging, have a chemist's label indicating the child's name and dosage to be given. Any child with an infectious disease or illness cannot to attend Vacation Care.

## PERSONAL COMPUTER GAMES / ELECTRONIC DEVICES

---

Electronic devices (e.g. iPod Touch, PSP, Nintendo DS etc.) can be brought to Vacation Care at your own risk. These cannot be played at times where other programmed activities are taking place. Only G-rated games can be played. Devices with a 3G-4G reception are not allowed. On devices equipped with a camera, photography of other children is not permitted.

## EXCURSIONS / INCURSIONS

All excursions and incursions are charged an additional fee which is outlined on the program. These fees will be added to your account once you have booked in according to the centre enrolment policy. It is important that children bring a water bottle on excursions days as they may not always have access to a bubbler at some venues. Any child that is required to be supplied a water bottle for an excursion will be charged an additional water bottle fee of \$2.00. **If you book your child in for a day there is an excursion designated, your child must attend that excursion. No outside activities like tennis or swimming will be allowed.**
