## PAYMENTS AND SOFTWARE SYSTEM

If you only use our service for Vacation Care please sign up for automatic deduction of your fees in the Kangaroo Time Connect APP. If you have not used Ironside OSHC for 8 weeks or more, please ensure that you have signed a new CWA prior to the commencement of Vacation Care. You will not be eligible for Childcare Subsidy until you have completed a new CWA.

Payments of fees are fortnightly and to be made via either of the following options. By using your KT App under the payments section, you can set up a direct debit request or make a manual payment when you receive your statement via email. Alternatively, you can pay via the school QKR App under Ironside State School go to Menu and choose Ironside OSHC fees. Statements are emailed every fortnight on a Monday evening and payment is required by Thursday on that week. Statements will be for 1 week and the following 1 week in advance

## BOOKINGS

All bookings are to be done via the KT app along with ensuring you complete the appropriate permission forms by using the QR code at the top of this document.

## EXTERNAL ACTIVITIES

Any bookings for external activities eg. tennis and swimming must be made via their booking requirements. All families must also complete the external activities permission form on our website if your child is attending these sessions in our care. Please note if your child is booked on a day they are to attend an excursion, they will not attend swimming or tennis between the hours of 9:00am to 3:00pm

# EASTER *Holiday* PROGRAM

## FOOD/DRINK

Children are required to bring morning tea and lunch each day. We will provide breakfast, afternoon tea and a fruit snack. We cannot reheat children's food. We strive to be a completely nut free and egg free service; please do not send these foods with your child. Please pack a water bottle. It is important that children bring a water bottle on excursion days as they may not always have access to a bubbler. Any child that is supplied a water bottle for an excursion will be charged an additional \$2.00.

## HATS/SHOES

All children must have a hat to play outside. It is also essential that all children wear enclosed shoes. Sneakers and socks are the best option as we have many sporting activities.

## SUN SAFETY

Parents are reminded that sun safe, appropriate outdoor clothing is always worn to minimise the risk of sun exposure. This means no sleeveless tops. Sunscreen will be provided to children. Please remember that on any water activity days ALL children must wear a sun shirt or a t shirt in the pool or for water play activities.

## MEDICATION/ILLNESS

If your child is required to take any medication whilst at OSHC, please complete a Medication administering form. Place the medication in a labelled ziplock bag. All medication must be in original packaging with chemist label indicating child's name and dosage to be given. Any child with infectious disease cannot attend.

## PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Electronic devices can be brought to Vacation Care at your own risk. These cannot be played at times where other programmed activities are taking place. Only G Rated games can be played. Devices with 3G/4G reception are not allowed. On devices equipped with a camera, photography of other children is not permitted.

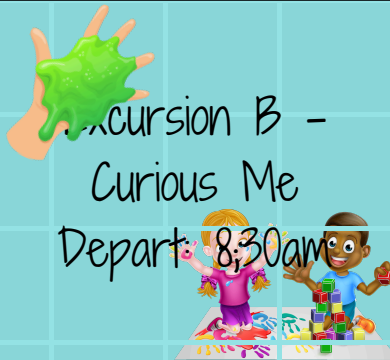

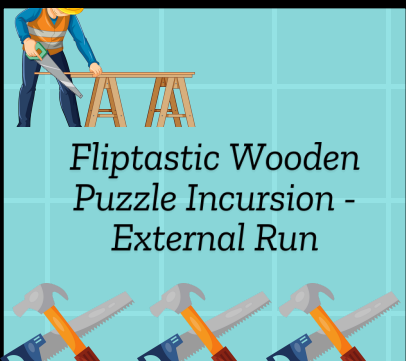
